**Dear members and friends.**

**As you all know Corona/Delta virus in some format is still with us.**

**As of last Sunday the Government issued new rules regarding attendance at public places, whereby the TAV HAYAROK (Green Pass) requirements have been reinstated including synagogues with more than 50 attendees.**

**The vast majority of our members and friends have either been vaccinated, have current negative test results, or have recovery certificates issued by Kupat Cholim. In order to simplify the method of identification and compliance when attending minyanim, we kindly request members, together with their close family members and friends, to send a scanned copy of their TAV YAROK (Green Pass) and/or relevant certificate to the Shul office to be kept on file. This will enable us to identify and verify those attending who are in compliance with the new rules.**

**Those unable to send email copies can contact Laura in the office with their details confirming their status. This information will not be shared with any third parties and kept in complete confidence.**

**It is also understood that there may be some members attending, who for various medical reasons, are not able to undergo vaccination, but who have been regularly tested through their Kupat Cholim.**

**According to the new regulations visitors will be requested to produce proof of vaccination.**

**I would like to remind all visiting the shul & using the facilities of the importance of:**

- 1. Wearing face masks correctly**
- 2. Practicing "social distancing" as we have learnt over the last 18 months**
- 3. Washing hands before entering the shul**

**Any person, who does not feel well, and/or shows any signs of fever or serious cough etc. is requested to remain at home until they have tested negative to**

**Corona.**
